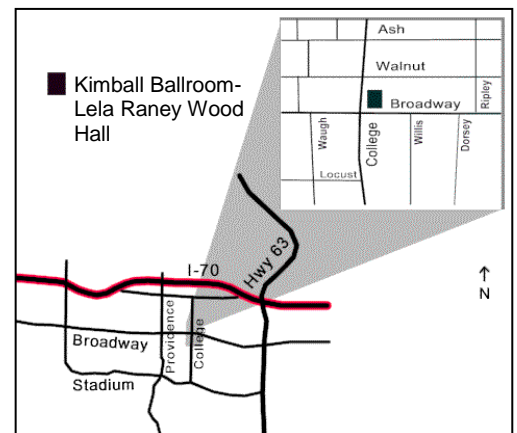
GENERAL INFORMATION
